Thessaloniki is located at the northern side of Greece, 500 km (310 miles) north of Athens. It is linked by air, train and bus with Athens and other European countries.

### **By Air**

Thessaloniki has its own international airport "Makedonia" and flights connect it with major European cities. There are several local flights connecting Thessaloniki to Athens. The airport is situated 16 km (10 miles) away from the city. Car hire services, coach and taxi services are all available at the airport. A taxi fare to the city centre is approximately 20€.
