LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear Friends,

1993 is proving to be a year to remember. This year will see the 10th Annual Conference of the ESVD. In such a short time the society has grown from 6 founder members to over 400 and still growing! It is time to reflect on what a great deal those founder members have given us and continue to give. Claudia von Tscharner, Didier Carlotti, Pierre Fourrier, David Lloyd, Ton Willemse and Hans Koch continue to be giants on the European Dermatological stage. We very much hope that all the founder members will be in Aalborg so that they can appreciate what a long way we have come and receive our thanks.

There have been problems of course and the board is currently tackling the recording of up to date lists of paid up members and the distribution of Veterinary Dermatology. However, I strongly feel that even though the organisation is growing rapidly, we remain essentially a family of good friends getting a lot of satisfaction from learning and helping others to learn about our speciality and that we can work together to solve the administrative problems as they arise.

The conference in Aalborg has been well planned. There is an excellent line-up of speakers. The ESVD is now recognised as one of the most important dermatological conferences world-wide and I am sure that each speaker (even the world famous ones!) would have been delighted to be invited to Denmark. This year's programme is particularly good and I am doing my best to advertise it. Congratulations will be due, I am sure, to Kristian Pedersen and his colleagues.

There are further meetings, conferences and courses in the pipeline. On the 6th October, 1993 we will have a pre-world-congress day in Berlin. This has been organised by Stefanie Peters and the speakers will be David Lloyd, Didier Carlotti, Ken Kwochka, Richard Halliwell, Richard Harvey and Luis Ferrer. Not a bad line-up! There will be a course on feline dermatology in Utrecht in 1994, - and others are in the thinking stage for 1995 and beyond. Plans are well advanced for the ESVD 1994 conference which will be in Bordeaux. This will be organised by Didier Carlotti, so we can be sure of a wonderful get together. I have already booked a few weeks off. Also in the thinking stage is the next world conference which will be a European affair in 1996, and a series of videos on dermatopathology (Pauline McNeil and Claudia von Tscharner). It's a great time to be a dermatologist!

Also in Europe, there have been substantial advances made on other fronts this year. A central board for the recognition of specialist qualifications has been set up and several of our prominent members are contributing to this. The European College of Veterinary Dermatology has come into being - its members coming, of course, from the ESVD. This is a very important step forward and we can look to ever increasing co-operation from the two organisations. We will work together on the organisation of conferences and the newly-formed college will, amongst other things, work towards the European Diploma in Dermatology.

Finally, I am very keen to increase the membership via a recruitment drive. The more members the more influence we will deserve in world affairs. The ESVD board is producing a leaflet which will briefly explain our aims, our philosophy, our meetings and courses and all the other benefits of membership. This leaflet will make joining a simple immediate affair and will be distributed widely via the membership. Some countries in Europe are well represented but we want to reach all European countries. If you are going to a dermatological meeting or speaking at one, please advertise the ESVD!

I look forward to welcoming as many of you as possible at our meetings - beginning in Aalborg.

ESVD can only develop in a healthy manner if individual members are prepared to raise their voices and contribute comments and ideas, suggestions as well as complaints - please speak to us!

Further Education

The ESVD remains committed to the provision of further education in veterinary dermatology with oncology, skin biology, clinical pathology and dermatohistopathology forming the core. This Annual Report includes details of a Workshop on Feline Dermatology due to take place in Utrecht, August 1994.

When it all began, some 10 years ago, it was envisaged that the further education courses provided by the ESVD would form part of the qualification for an ESVD certificate in veterinary dermatology. Since then a number of changes, most notably the development of national certificates and diplomas in veterinary dermatology and the formation of the European College of Veterinary Dermatology, has necessitated a review of this commitment. It is the Board's view that the plan for ESVD examinations and certificates should be abandoned and that members should work towards one of the national certificates and/or an ECVD diploma as their specialist qualification. However, it is appreciated that some members did attend core courses with the specific intention of qualifying for examination to certificate level at some point in the future. There needs to be a dialogue so if you have any views on this subject, once again, please speak to us!

At the last Annual General Meeting in Rome, September 1992, it was noted that courses in Clinical Pathology (Lyon) and Oncology (Barcelona) were expected for 1993. Following the election of the new board and, at its first meeting at the end of October 1992, the election of myself as chairman of the Further Education Committee, it was decided to postpone the Oncology course but press ahead with plans for the Clinical Oncology course in Lyon. Unfortunately, this had to be cancelled at the last minute because insufficient numbers had been able to register by the closing date. We apologise, once again, to those who did register and assure them that we are endeavouring to stage a successful course at the same venue in July 1994.

Membership fees:

Vet Derm Subscription:

In 1992 and for the moment, the Vet Derm subscriptions are not covering the Vet derm cost.

The listing and the addresses of the subscribers have been reviewed and sent to Pergamon Press Ltd.

"Miscellaneous":

It's mostly (XEU 1450) the registration for the ESVD Lyon course which was cancelled. The ESVD owes this money to the members involved.

EXPENSES

Meeting and travel Expenses:

These expenses represent two board meetings (Hatfield Oct 92 and Paris May 93). The next board meeting would be held in Aalborg so the transport and accommodation costs would be reduced.

Vet Derm:

This nearly represents the expense for the whole year as we paid for the 1992 vol.

Bank Charges:

This budgetary item is increasing this year as there are more payments (fee and subscription). We pay about XEU 10 for an Eurocheque.

We recommend payment by Bank transfer if possible.

Some members ask for a Visa payment. For the moment, that's not possible with our Bank, but it's true it would be easier for everybody and we are

looking for that (even if we have to change our Bank).

General Comments

1. As the outcome from a congress is always uncertain in both directions, and as a failure for whatever reason would have dramatic results, we need to always have a positive account of more than XEU 30.000 (on year budget of society).
2. Next year, the membership fee will gather the fee itself and Vet Derm subscription, at a lower price than this year: XEU 90 (bank transfer), XEU 100 (Eurocheque), that is to say that every ESVD member will receive Vet Derm and pay less money....The board decided on this change because
 - more than 90% of the members are paying for both
 - it would be easier for Pergamon to send each issue to each member
 - it is more attractive for new members

We know that some members are receiving Vet Derm directly (ACVD members, consulting editor). The particular members would have to pay only XEU 50 (Bank Transfer) or XEU 60 (Eurocheque).

NEWS FROM NATIONAL REPRESENTATIVES

BELGIUM

The Belgian working group on veterinary dermatology is very healthy. Our annual congress of 13.12.92 was a lively meeting of veterinary colleagues and the pharmaceutical firms. There were 280 participants.

This year, on December 5, the day of our annual congress 1993, we will add conferences in English (with simultaneous translation) to our programme. In this way, we hope to encourage participation by our neighbour countries and give a European dimension to our congress.

Several members of the committee are taking, or have taken courses to obtain a certificate in dermatology, as part of the French C.E.S., or the European E.S.A.V.S.

The Dermatohistopathology laboratory, run by two of our group members, has received an excellent response from colleagues interested in dermatology in Belgium.

DENMARK

The main activity in 1992 and for much of 1993 has been the organisation of the 10th ESVD Annual Congress 1993. We sincerely hope that many delegates will find their way to Aalborg and Denmark, spending three days together under the flag of dermatology and friendship. At the time of writing delegates have registered from most European countries, Canada, Iran, Japan and USA.

A two day meeting was arranged in November 1992 on the subject 'Feline Dermatology'. The speaker was Dr Donna Walton Angarano, Auburn University, Alabama. 70 veterinarians from Germany, Sweden and Denmark attended the meeting.

FRANCE

In 1992, the Annual meeting of the French Group of Veterinary Dermatology (GEDAC) took place in Paris on 20th November during the C.N.V.S.P.A. meeting, and was attended by 180 delegates. Many interesting topics were covered including Granulomatous Dermatitis (L. Ferrer), Interface Dermatitis (J.P. Magnol), Cutaneous cytology (C. Fournel, D.N. Carlotti). Clinical cases were also presented by members. Two seminars at

comprehensive level of 4 days each were held in Lyon (March) and in Bordeaux (October), and were attended by 80 veterinarians.

The main activity of the GEDAC in 1993 was a three day Congress in May in Saint Malo. This meeting was attended by 130 delegates. The main themes were Hereditary dermatoses and Keratinization defects, presented by K.W. Kowchka (Colombus, USA), C.L.B. Blanchet-Bardon (Paris, France), B. Atlee (Davis, USA), Th. Olivry (Davis, USA), Z. Alhaidari (Lomme, France), B. Hubert (Beziers, France). A very interesting series of short communications was also presented by the members. For the first time in France, breakfasts were arranged with members of the GEDAC as speakers. This programme covered flea control (D.N. Carlotti), Dermatitis associated with Malassezzia (Z. Alhaidari, B. Atlee), Management of Dermatophytosis (C. Prost). The social programmes were memorable with an event in the Mont Saint Michel and an event in a very typical castle.

A three day seminar on dermatohistopathology will take place in the Veterinary School of Lyon in October, 1993 (the speakers will be J.P. Magnol, Cl. Von Tscharner, L. Ferrer, M. Lagadic, M. Delverdier, Th. Marschall, D.N. Carlotti, C. Fournel). This meeting will be attended by 35 veterinarians.

For the pre-congress day prior to the C.N.V.S.P.A. meeting, the GEDAC will present a programme devoted to topographic dermatology (pinnae, anus, scrotum, vulva...) and psychodermatology.

SPAIN

In Barcelona (3-4 October, 1992) a Dermatological seminar was held with the first AVEPA local division. The speakers were Dr Carlotti and Dr Kwochka. This meeting included Atopy/Flea allergy diagnosis, antiparasitic therapy, Pyoderma, Demodicosis, Endocrine dermatoses.

During the Annual Congress of AVEPA, the Spanish group of Dermatology organised a meeting (November, 1992) in Sitges (Barcelona) and the topics were:

- Parasitic skin diseases (Dr A. Rios)

AMVAC celebrated the 10th annual meeting in Madrid (May, 1993) with Dr Dunstan as speaker. The topic was Dermatohistopathology.

In San Sebastian (May, 1993) a whole day seminar was held with Dr L. Ferrer (Congenital dermatoses) and Dr Carlotti (Atopy/Flea Allergy and diagnosis).

In Santiago de Compostela (Galicia), AVEPA local division organised a basic course in dermatology (June, 1993). The themes were:

SWEDEN

In Sweden we try to have two meetings a year in the Swedish Veterinary Dermatology Study Group one meeting in springtime and one in the autumn. In 1992 the first meeting was held in Sundsvall in the northern part of Sweden. Organizers this time were Hildegunn Kasström and Maria Kjellberg, who had found a lovely place for us to stay in. The subjects differed a little bit and were based on case-presentations and discussions. A couple of days where colleagues shared with and helped each other with interesting and difficult cases.

The autumn meeting, also the annual meeting in SVDSG, was held in Stockholm and was arranged by three persons, Ann Edman, Inger Karlsson and Margareta Welander.

The first morning, the subject was Essential Fatty Acids. Dr Richard G. Harvey gave us some practical advice on how to use fatty acids in dogs and cats and Dr Sharon Dobbin talked about new areas of research.

Guest speaker in the afternoon was Dr Kristian Pedersen from Denmark who gave an excellent lecture on Pyoderma in good Danish-Swedish.

We also had the opportunity to visit BIOVET-lab, where we were shown the whole procedure of making preparations for histopathology.

The first meeting of 1993 was held on an island - beautiful Öland outside the Swedish eastcoast. The organiser was Marja Wolf for SVDSG who succeeded very well, even with unreliable Swedish weather. This meeting was held in English as we had two brilliant speakers from Great Britain - Dr Richard Halliwell and Dr Joan Rest. The topic was Immunological Skin Diseases, a big and difficult area but presented in the "easy way" of our two very popular speakers.

UNITED KINGDOM

The British Veterinary Dermatology Study Group has held three meetings since the last Annual Report was published. In April 1992 the pre BSAVA Congress Meeting heard papers on the subjects of endocrine control of hair growth, diagnosis of thyroid diseases, histopathological features of endocrine alopecia, the 'hepatocutaneous syndrome' and the use of cytological preparations in dermatological practice. Short communications on a neutrophil defect in Irish setters, sterile eosinophilic pustulosis, poxvirus and guinea pig cheilitis and a comparison of mounting fluids used for the examination of skin scrapings were presented.

The Autumn meeting of the British Veterinary Study Group was held at the Bristol School of Veterinary Science over two days. Papers were presented on the distribution of *P.acnes* on 11 dogs, the serological response to *S.intermedius* in the dog, canine anal furunculosis, the recovery of *M.pachydermatitis* from the canine skin, an overview of the cutaneous immune response, strategies for control of dermatophytosis, recent advances in ectoparasite control and strategies for managing recurrent pyoderma. Short communications were presented on coital exanthema in a horse, photosensitisation in a horse and Malassezid dermatitis.

In April 1993 the pre BSAVA Congress Meeting heard papers on the subjects of integrins and epidermal differentiation, the non-surgical management of cutaneous neoplasia and defects in keratinisation in the dog. Short communications were presented on lupoid dermatosis, scabies in cats and alopecia areata in dogs.

In addition to the activities of the Dermatology Study Group, the Royal Veterinary College held two Dermatology Seminars, one on aetiology, diagnosis and treatment of alopecia and one on

cutaneous inflammation and its control. The theme for this year's BSAVA Scottish Scientific Weekend was dermatology with David Grant and Pauline McNeil as the speakers. Veterinary Dermatology has also been presented by individual ESVD members to continuing education courses, local practitioner meetings and breeder's congresses.
