## Publications

---

Again, as in the past, I am thankful to the Board members, and to our new secretary, Pamela Silkstone, who provided me with the material published in this edition of the **Annual Report**. A special thank to Thierry Olivry, who once again provided us with his very useful veterinary dermatology reference list.

The **ESVD Bulletin** is an important and efficient means of communication to and between members, thanks to the wonderful work of its tireless editor, Tim Nuttall. To the reports of past courses and congresses, the announcements of future national and international meetings in veterinary dermatology, new useful items have been added, such as the "Web Watch", a number of web pages related to dermatology, and the "Abstract Watch", comments on recently published articles. It is the intention of the editor and of the Board to try to move the publication of the Bulletin from December and April of each year to September and March, in order to include other mailings to the members and save postal costs. For this reason some items, e.g. the reports of the ESVD Annual Meeting, will be published in the spring issue instead of the autumn one. Please remember that as member of the ESVD, the Bulletin is also yours. The Editor will be pleased to receive comments, letters, reports of past meetings, announcements of future courses and congresses to be published on this wonderful means of reaching more than 600 persons in the world with a special interest in veterinary dermatology!

The year 2001 has been the first for Ian Mason as Editor-in-chief and the last for Ross Bond as European Co-Editor of **Veterinary Dermatology**. We would like to thank them both, together with the American Co-Editor, Karen Moriello, for their wonderful work. From the beginning of 2002 Peter Hill, from the University of Edinburgh, will be the new European Co-Editor. We all wish him a good work.

For the first year in 2001 Veterinary Dermatology has been published in 6 issues, and increased its page number from an average of 300 to 350. Consequently, the number of articles has increased and the time between receipt, acceptance

and publication of an article has decreased. Furthermore, abstracts from the World Congress of Veterinary Dermatology 4 in San Francisco and from the AAVD/ACVD Annual Meeting have been included and those from the ESVD Congress are anticipated, as a useful reference for those who could not participate in the meetings.

Unfortunately, in 2001 the impact factor and ranking of Veterinary Dermatology decreased (from 0.833 to 0.658 and from 34th to 45th, respectively). This may be due to the higher number of articles published or to the publication of two non peer-reviewed supplements, the first dedicated to equine dermatology and the second containing congress abstracts. However, while understanding that maintaining a high impact factor helps attracting good quality publications, we are of the opinion that the publication of abstracts of veterinary dermatology congresses a long time before the publication of the full peer-reviewed articles, is a useful service to the readers.

For computer maniacs Veterinary Dermatology can also be found on line. Electronic subscriptions permit the rapid download of all articles, including abstracts of most of the cited references. For more information please visit the web site <http://www.blackwell-science.com/vde>.

Last, but not least, our web site, <http://www.esvd.org> has been recently completely updated and looks more attractive and user-friendly. There you will find updated information regarding future ESVD courses and direct links to the organisers' e-mail addresses. We would like to thank David Lloyd for his wonderful help in setting up this web site and contributing to its maintenance.

### **ESVD Grant**

---

ESVD wishes to encourage high standards in all aspects of veterinary dermatology and to promote the development of related research. Therefore, an annual research grant has been awarded since 1996 by the ESVD for basic or clinical research in veterinary dermatology. Each grant is to the value of **5,000 Euros**.

Ordinarily projects are expected to be of one to two years' duration. Applicants are expected to propose a project of scientific merit that is applicable to veterinary dermatology. Grants are evaluated on scientific merit, feasibility, and usefulness. Preference will be given to novel proposals including the development of pilot studies. Applications for support of some identifiable component of an ongoing research work will also be considered. It is not the intention to provide funds for single items of capital expenditure. Please note that the Society is not in a position to support the costs of institutional overheads. Any use of experimental animals must conform to the local ethical and animal welfare regulations.

Proposals should be received by April 1 each year for consideration by the grant awarding committee. Research proposals (four copies) should be sent to the current ESVD Publications and Grant secretary (Dr. Chiara Noli, Viale dei Mille 26, 20129 Milano). An acknowledgement will be sent. All applications will be subject to peer review and must include background information, project aims and objectives, project design, specific methods, budget together with an explanation of the relevance of the proposed work to veterinary dermatology, as described in the guidelines. The award will be granted and announced at the next AGM of the Society. Payment of the grant will be made into a special account and a budget report will be required by the ESVD Treasurer at the end of the study. Any funds not spent must be returned to the ESVD. Annual progress reports are required and should be submitted to the current Publications and Grant Secretary at least 30 days before the Society's AGM.

Successful applicants will be expected to submit their results for publication in Veterinary Dermatology and to present their findings to ESVD members at an ESVD Annual Congress **within three years** from receipt of the grant. The funds cannot be used for travel and accommodation at the meeting but only for research. However, the principal awardee is entitled to free registration at any ESVD Annual Congress at which he or she will present the data generated as a result of the grant.

Proposals should be prepared according to the following guidelines. As far as is practically possible, the proposals will be evaluated anonymously. Therefore, please include names, addresses and other identifying information only on the title page. Please make every effort to have no identifying information in the body of the proposal. Submitted along with the body of the proposal, as a separate document, should be one copy of the curriculum vitae of each of the principal investigators.

**Guidelines for Preparation of ESVD Grant Applications:**

Applications not adhering to these guidelines may be excluded from consideration. The number of pages listed are maximum numbers. Shorter proposals are acceptable and welcomed.

**Section 1 (one page maximum)**

Title page should include the project title, the name and title of the investigator, the institute at which the research will be performed, and the dates of the proposed project period.

**Section 2. (one page maximum)**

- i) Provide a brief abstract with clearly stated objectives and the importance of the research, the experimental design and the methods used for achieving the stated objectives.
- ii) Specific aim(s): State in general terms the long term objective(s) and the hypothesis to be tested.

**Section 3 (2 pages maximum)**

**Background and significance:** In this section, briefly review the background for the present proposal, and the gaps in knowledge that the proposed project will fill.

**Section 4 (2 pages maximum)**

**Preliminary studies:** If there are preliminary data to support the hypothesis or to demonstrate that the investigator is familiar with the proposed methods, they should be included. If there are no preliminary results, then this section can be omitted.

**Section 5 (4 pages maximum)**

- i) **Experimental design and methods:** This section should contain a concise discussion of the experimental design and the procedures to be used to accomplish the specific aims listed above. This section should be sufficiently detailed so that the feasibility may be judged. This section should list a brief description of resources available to investigators. It is important to discuss the means by which the data will be collected, analysed and interpreted, and the controls that will be required to allow a proper analysis. The type of statistical evaluation to be used for data analysis should be briefly detailed. Investigators should justify the sizes of experimental groups.
- ii) **Animal use:** Projects must fulfil the requirements of legislation in force in the country in which the work is to be performed. A statement to this effect should be included in the application. Any project proposal involving animals must be evaluated by the applicant's institution animal use committee and a statement to that effect should also be included in the proposal. If pets are to be used in the project, a permission form for the owners to complete should be appended to the proposal. Unless animal care and use has been carefully addressed, a proposal can not be considered for funding.

**Section 6 (one page maximum)**

A one page detailed budget should be included. The ESVD will not subsidise professional veterinary fees incurred by clients in the investigation of animals involved in clinical projects.

**Section 7 (one page maximum)**

References should be provided for Section 3 (background information) and section 4 (methods).

## **Minutes of the 16<sup>th</sup> AGM of the ESVD**

Held at the Falconer Auditorium, Falconer Congress Centre, Copenhagen on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> September 2001.

#### **President's address**

The AGM was opened by Dominique Héripert who thanked Flemming Kristensen for the successful organisation of the congress in Copenhagen. Special thanks were also given to all the sponsors of the meeting.

#### **Treasurer's report**

Trevor Whitbread analysed the income of congress organization, workshops and costs. The balance of the ESVD accounts for the period 01-01-01 to 31-08-01 was presented. It was underlined that it is very important that all members pay on time their annual fee because otherwise it is not possible to maintain regular delivery of Veterinary Dermatology without financial loss for the ESVD.

#### **Membership Secretary report**

Margreet Vroom reported that the total number of members was 625, with 12 deleted in 2001 and 48 new members. The number of Full Members (not including the new ones) was 198.

#### **Publication Officer's report**

Chiara Noli thanked David Lloyd for the Web page, Tim Nuttall for editing the Bulletin, and also Thierry Olivry for the Annual Report. She spoke about Veterinary Dermatology and anticipated the publication of abstracts presented at the AAVD and ESVD meetings.

The questionnaire about the possibility of having Veterinary Dermatology on-line was characterised only by less than 50% of consensus and for this reason this matter will be reconsidered by the ESVD Board in two or three years time.

#### **Further education committee**

Zeineb Alhaidari reported about the Dermatopathology workshop in London and the Feline Dermatology workshop organised in the Netherlands. She gave information about future workshops which will be held in July in France (Clinical Pathology) and about a new workshop in spring in Sweden (Equine Dermatology).

#### **Research Committee**

Chiara Noli reported on previous grants and publications. This year she received only two applications. The ESVD Grant was won by Claude Favrot, Depart. Sciences Cliniques, Faculté Med. Vét., Université Montreal, Quebec Canada, with the title "Investigation in the serological immunodiagnosis of canine subepidermal autoimmune blistering skin diseases".

### **Future Meetings**

Future meetings were also discussed and Zeineb Alhaidari presented the scientific and social programme of the 18th ESVD Annual Congress in Nice, 2002, and she announced that the 2003 ESVD Congress would be held in Tenerife.

### **ESVD Board Elections**

A.Vercelli presented the results of the ESVD Board election. The election committee formed by Antonella Vercelli and Margreet Vroom received 115 vote forms back. The list proposed for the postal vote was composed of 20 new candidates and 3 Board members seeking re-election.

**Margreet Vroom (NL) was elected President with 107 votes and Dominique Héripert (F) became Past President.**

## INCOME

### **Membership fee**

In the year 2001, ESVD counted 6 free members (4 Honorary, 2 Retired).

### **Investment Account**

Interest rates again throughout Europe are now low and probably will remain so giving us a low interest on the account overall.

### **Annual congress**

The final balance of the accounts for an annual congress are usually completed in the year following the congress. The year 2000 was a world derm congress year and we therefore have no income from the annual congress for this period.

### **Other income**

ESVD residents account returned 10,000 euro to the main account this year and 1027.44 euro was returned by Cathy Curtis as the residuum of the grant following completion of her research project. As veterinary dermatology becomes more popular and acquires a larger circulation, the profits which the society receives from Blackwell are also slowly increasing. It is worth reminding members that the journal is actually owned by the society, Blackwell are simply contracted to publish the journal for the members.

## EXPENSES

### **Meeting & Travel Expenses**

We had two board meetings, one in Milan and one in Copenhagen. We felt there was not the necessity to have the customary November board meeting during 2001, hence the meeting and travel expenses are again at a modest level.

### **Veterinary Dermatology**

This has increased again this year as expected and will continue to do so with the advent of two extra issues per year.

### **Bank Charges**

These have increased slightly, mainly due to increased use of credit cards for payment.

### **Secretary and mailing**

Surprisingly this has not significantly increased but there are some expenses that have not been presented until 2002.

### **ESVD publications**

There is a marked increase in this figure partly due to late presentation of invoices for work carried out in the year 2000.

### **Miscellaneous**

This includes 100 euro for our membership of Fecava but also 940 euro for the establishing and maintaining of our website. This will be an ongoing cost.

### **EDVD Grant**

This was awarded for the year 2001 to Claude Favrot and Thierry Olivry.

### **US Bank account**

We still maintain a modest sum in the US bank account which we use for paying expenses to American speakers where possible.

**UK Bank account**

As previously, this includes payment in pounds sterling and also payment by Visa and I would anticipate a continuing increase in the up-take of payment by Visa.

**Dutch Account**

As you know we maintain a small reserve in a Dutch account to pay for secretarial and other expenses. At the end of the year 2001, reserves totalled 2999.85 Euro.

**GENERAL COMMENTS**

Despite the absence of any income from an annual congress, the balance has significantly increased but much of this is due to the bringing forward of the annual subscriptions and this includes quite a substantial proportion of subscriptions for the year 2002. We have tried over the last two or three years to impress upon members that early payment of membership dues is necessary in order to make the running of the society easier and less expensive. We have attempted to do this in a number of ways including levying a surcharge for late payment but with limited success.

The Visa facility is increasing in popularity as a method of paying subscriptions. With the advent of the euro, payment by cheque may become the preferred method for members within the euro zone and when the bank charges for transfer of funds in this way reduce, as is the intention, then this will become the most cost effective method of payment.




